My fears were allayed soon enough because I had the support of the stalwarts and some of the most driven young members as my executive committee. With them by my side, the past year has flown by in the blink of an eye, and what an incredible journey it has been. Organizing and executing events for our esteemed alumni came with its fair share of challenges, but the joy of watching SJOBA grow from strength to strength has been truly gratifying. This year was about togetherness, expansion, and creating new traditions. We hosted, for the very first time, the President & Friends of SJOBA Dinner - a gesture to honour our sponsors who have supported us unwaveringly over the years. We also took a bold leap by launching the first-ever stand-alone Time-Speed-Distance Rally. With over 45 participants, it set a national record for the northern region. From there, the momentum only grew:

- ▶ The Winter Ball sparkled with music and magic, with Gurnazar leaving the crowd mesmerised and dancing.
- ▶ The SJOBA Extreme Rally and the SSS witnessed 60+ bikers and 30+ four-wheelers taking to the roads with roaring passion.
- ▶ The SJOBA Marathon was revived with an impressive 602 participants.
- ▶ The Post-Rally Dinner at Mac Sir's residence was another tradition rekindled along with St. John's SJOBA debate.
- ▶ The SJOBA Cyclothon was launched.
- ▶ The first ever SJOBA Founders' Day Dinner was hosted on the 19th of July 2025.



Alongside these events, the focus was on strengthening connections within our fraternity. Some new WhatsApp groups were created/extended for alumni across Australia and New Zealand, the Middle East, Bengaluru, and most importantly, the Tricity. OUR BEST FRIEND - Br. McCann

Look, your teacher is coming! This one line tends to send shivers down the spine of students even today but for us, it used to be a welcome visit. Every student who has passed out from St. John's High School during Brother McCann's time can relate to him riding a bicycle down to his house and it used to be a pleasure to receive him. It used to be a moment of joy for every student of his.

Brother McCann, till his last breath, kept his ties intact with his students. He believed that a teacher is a person of many parts. I recollect him telling me during one of our conversations, "A teacher is a person who not only gives you knowledge but is your companion too. He is the one who would always stand by your side whenever you need him." And all his students would agree that he lived up to this his entire life. A fracture in the leg riddled him from riding a bicycle but could not take away his spirit. He still continued his visits to his students. The only difference was this that the school 'Maruti Van' used to drop him to a student's place and from there that student would drop him to another's place and this would go on till the time he got tired and finally one of us would drop him back to the Brother's residence at the school campus.

So, not only his students, all those who have lived in Chandigarh for long and ever saw a six-feet, fair, Irish gentleman, striding his

bicycle on the roads of the city beautiful, can certainly take that man to be Brother McCann. But remember, he was never there to pass time, he used to be around on a very special mission, a mission of visiting his old students and enquiring about their wellbeing. I once asked him about his love for the bicycle and he smilingly said, "It is not a mere mode of transport but also an exercise that keeps me fit and fine."

Brother McCann was not only a wonderful teacher, he was also an elderly friend to many a youngster in town. He is a person who will always remain an integral part of the life of his students. His wonderful thoughts, wide perspective and moral values will always help his students to surge ahead in life. He dedicated 60 odd years of his life imparting education and inspiring hundreds of students across various schools in India being run by the Irish Missionaries. I wonder if today's generation would ever have mentors like him.

I am proud that I have been one of his students. You do not come across such wonderful teachers very often in life. If you have a teacher like him, then you do not have to worry about anything because he is always there to guide and help you out and to take away your blues. He was one of those few teachers who dedicated his entire life preparing his students for facing the one final examination called 'Life.'


The Annual SJOBA-St. John's Debate
